

Post from the Pulpit

Dear Beloved Community,

As we enter the season of Advent, we are reminded that it is a time of expectant waiting, a time of preparation. We wait not only for the celebration of Christ's birth but also for the presence of Christ in our lives. Advent is a season that invites us to slow down, to reflect, and to make room in our hearts for the hope, peace, joy, and love that Jesus brings. If you're like me and need some reminders or examples on how to slow down and reflect during this busy season, here are a few spiritual practices you could incorporate into your routine this Advent season:

Daily Scripture Reading: Set aside time, maybe with a cup of coffee or hot chocolate to read and reflect on the scripture passages from the Advent lectionary. This simple practice will help you focus your heart on the "reason for the season".

Prayer: Contemplative prayer can be a meaningful way to help quiet yourself and slow down...Practice taking deep breaths and focus on the presence of God. You can choose a word or theme as you sit in prayer. Even sitting with one word each week, like peace, hope, joy or love can be a meaningful experience.

Acts of Kindness: Advent is the time of sharing and giving. Can you look for small ways to bless those around you? Could you consider contributing to our Reverse Advent Calendar for the Food Pantry? Or maybe you could participate in the Giving Tree to support two local families with Christmas gifts? Maybe you could be intentional with sending Christmas cards with words of encouragement to a friend.

Be mindful of your pace: Consider how quickly you do things and if you're always in a hurry. Give yourself permission to slow down or be kind to yourself when you may not be moving as fast as you want to be.

As we journey together during this time of anticipation, may we open our hearts and our minds to the presence of the Divine already in our midst, may we center ourselves in the love of God, wait with patience, and anticipate with joyful expectation.


